## Pikes Peak Area Zonta September 2017 Newsletter

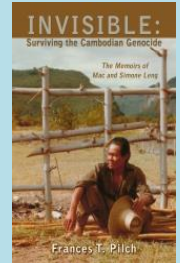
Welcome to the newly revised Pikes Peak Area Zonta Club quarterly newsletter, your source of information and inspiration throughout the Zonta Year!

The Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) was passed by Congress in 1972 and was ratified by 35 of the necessary 38 state legislatures, but even with an extension of the ratification deadline to 1982, organized anti-equality political, economic, social, and religious forces prevented any further state ratifications until this year, when Nevada ratified the ERA 35 years after the deadline. After more than a generation of significant advances for women, do we still need the Equal Rights Amendment? The answer is an unqualified yes!
