




12th Annual Human Trafficking Symposium



News from the 2019 Zonta International District 12 Centennial Conference in Billings, Montana, September 20-22.

Seize the Zonta Spirit -- Honor and Empower Her

The District 12 conference was a fabulous learning opportunity, a great way to catch up with Zonta friends and network, and a time to vote for future Zonta District 12 leaders and on important issues.

Attendees also were able to meet District 12's International Liaison Sigrid Duden, as well as other dignitaries.

The Conference started off with an historic evening at Prescott Hall,
Rocky Mountain College, where attendees enjoyed appetizers and beverages,
competed for best costume. Pikes Peak Zonta member Samantha Bruzan won
the contest with her portrayal of Florence Nightingale. Sam is a nurse in real
life, as well. Congratulations to Sam and a big thank you to
Sam and to Debbie Manzanares, who served as delegates for our club.

The Conference officially opened on Saturday morning, with meetings throughout the day and the much anticipated Awards Banquet in the evening. Zonta Pikes Peak was honored at the banquet for 70 years as a Colorado Springs club. Delegates voted on various matters and for our 2020-22 District 12 leaders. Congratulations to Zonta Pikes Peak member Sonya Bergeron, who was elected Area 4 Director! (Area 4 includes the Pikes Peak Club in Colorado Springs, the Royal Gorge Club in Cañon City, and the Prowers County Club, serving Lamar and surrounding areas.) On Sunday, in addition to a brunch and final meetings, a memorial service was held. Zonta Pikes Peak president Liz Groothof Croddy spoke about our beloved Shannon Rowan, whose work with girls aging out of foster care continues via the Shannon Rowan Memorial Fund. Zonta PPA member Susie Nulty created a memorial card which featured inspirational quotes from various women, plus a bag containing a Colorado wildflower seed mix.

No conference is complete without a number of silent auction items, raffle baskets and other sales! The Zonta PPA table, organized by Susie, was a big hit, earning our club over \$350, with many repeat customers.

Our contribution to the District 12 Scholarship raffle basket was donated by Zonta PPA treasurer Melissa Marts, and included, among other Coloradothemed items, a candle featuring a mountain range which, when lit, would evoke a Colorado sunset.

President's Corner

It was a dark and stormy night. That's the night in 1988 when Betty Edwards and I joined the Pikes Peak Area Zonta Club. The club was so small then that we were both installed as board members on that very same evening!

In this newsletter, I am reflecting on why I became a member of Zonta. My goals in joining were the same I have today: to make a difference in my community... to make a difference in my world... to meet, become friends with, and gain inspiration from women outside of my usual career contacts... to learn.

Inspiration. Ripples. Engagement. More ripples.

Betty went on to become president of Zonta Pikes Peak (as well as governor of Zonta International District 12, comprised of Colorado, Montana, South Dakota and Wyoming), and to found the Human Trafficking Task Force of Southern Colorado, which has profoundly changed our community's understanding of human trafficking and brought forward real solutions, advocating for important legislation for our state and inspiring similar efforts in other Colorado communities. The Task Force now works independently, with continued participation from our club, such as through Zonta Wings, a fund established by member Sharon Roggy. We engage in fundraising every year to ensure that when an emergency arises, Zonta Pikes Peak can immediately make Zonta Wings funds available to help a victim

escape her trafficker. Worldwide, the **Zonta Says NO!** campaign has raised awareness of and brought solutions for ending violence against women. Inspired by these efforts, I studied the connection between human trafficking and found out about its impact on our environment, and then joined Kevin Bales, author **Blood and Earth: Modern Slavery, Ecocide, and the Secret to Saving the World** (as well as many other books about human trafficking and slavery) in raising awareness on a local radio program (KCMJ's *Voices and Views with Judith McKay*) and went on to speak about the topic at a Zonta meeting in 2017. And this year we honored Roger Patrizio, who chaired the Task Force for several years, as our #HeForShe for 2019, for fighting violence against women (and men) means that women (and men) must join forces in order to fulfill the vision of Zonta:

Zonta International envisions a world in which women's rights are recognized as human rights and every woman is able to achieve her full potential.

In such a world, women have access to all resources and are represented in decision making positions on an equal basis with men.

In such a world, no woman lives in fear of violence.

Inspiration. Ripples. Engagement. More ripples.

In future newsletters I'll let you know more about different ways our club is #MakingADifference in our community and the world.

To make a difference.. that is why I joined Zonta.

Saturday, Nov. 9 – Join Zonta of Denver to march at the Denver Veterans Parade! Costumes are optional!


