





Into the New Year, we'll continue to meet via Zoom, and we invite you to join us each month for an uplifting conversation and gifted speakers, including our first program of the year, January 7, when we'll celebrate our own Amelia Earhart with a speaker representing women in aviation, and on February 4, with a program on women in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math), and, in collaboration with seven other women's organizations, at our annual International Women's Day celebration the first Saturday in March! launched a multi-month "Sisters in Science" program on Zoom, featuring two siblings who both went into a STEM field. Our first of two fall programs was held in collaboration with the Colorado Springs Science Festival, and we'll continue the series into the New Year.




